

Hospital's leading the way

CAMPBELLTOWN Private Hospital opened its doors in April 2007 and is operated by Healthscope - the second largest and one of the most respected providers of private hospital services in Australia.

Since its opening, Campbelltown Private Hospital has had three major redevelopments to cope with service demands and is currently planning another one.

Right now the hospital has eight state of the art operating theatres, a day surgery, 82 surgical beds and a 34-bed rehabilitation centre as well as onsite medical and nuclear imaging services.

The hospital was the first to use robotic surgery service in southwest Sydney in either the public or the private sector.

It boasts a high volume urological robotic centre and surgeons travel to Campbelltown from throughout NSW to be trained in robotic surgical techniques by specialists Dr Kayvan Haghighi and Dr Pascal Mancuso.

It was also one of the first hospitals to provide robotic head and neck surgery

through Dr John McGuinness. In recent times, through the dedication of specialist breast surgeon Dr Andrew Ong, the hospital has introduced a second generation perfusion

scanner called the SPY. The advanced capabilities of this equipment provides patients with access to the latest treatment available.

The many technological firsts introduced by the

hospital - together with an ongoing commitment to improved care and outcomes - has enabled it to attract leading surgical specialists from around Sydney who now provide established

consultation and surgical services to the Macarthur community.

Other leading surgical provisions at the hospital include bariatric surgery for obese patients and orthopaedic services.

Plastic surgeon Dr Michael Kernohan is part of the multi-disciplinary team working toward the introduction of a melanoma unit to Liverpool and Campbelltown which will mean people will not have to travel to RPA and the North Shore for this service.

Many of the hospital's specialist team work within the public system.

This collaborative rela-

tionship means local health services will keep improving, ensuring the patients within the region have the ability to access world class health services locally.
