**Hundreds of people turned out dressed in a rainbow of colours to raise vital funds for medical services in**

MORE than 800 people and 91 teams dressed in a rainbow of colours to raise vital funds for local medical services at the 24 Hour Fight Against Cancer Macarthur on the weekend.

Founder and chairman Fred Borg said the fundraiser, which started at Campbelltown Athletics Centre at 10am on Saturday, included an emotional reflection ceremony that night.

“The track was full of people celebrating their love for each other, their love for survivors, and the love and memory of the ones who have lost their lives,” he said.

Mr Borg said the fight raised \$350,000 last year to bring the total raised in 11 years to \$3.4 million.
